Requirements & Restrictions

Before your Appointment:

- Complete ALL pages of Form 13614-C (Intake/Interview & Quality Review Booklet) Copies at Harper LCC Reception
- If you have tax documents on your phone or other digital devices, you must print them out prior to your visit.
- If you need language assistance you must find an interpreter yourself appointments are in English.
- If you are a student:
 - 1. Know if your parents are claiming you as a dependent or 2. We may need to view your school's financial statement. if you are supporting yourself.
- - Prepare total expenses for required books & supplies. 3.

Bring all Relevant Documents on the Day of your Appointment:

- **REQUIRED:** Government-issued Photo ID for you (& your spouse if married filing jointly). Both spouses MUST be present unless the spouse in attendance has a financial Power of Attorney for the absent spouse.
- **REQUIRED: Social Security card or ITIN** for ALL people on the return, including dependents. Accepted formats: 1) Social Security Card; 2) SSA-1099 form showing all 9 digits of your SSN; or 3) prior year's tax return prepared by the Tax-Aide program or a professional preparer.
- All IRS letters such as IRS-issued Identity Protection PIN (If you have received one)
- **2023 Tax Year Documents.** Please bring all tax documents that you received. Most of these documents come in envelopes marked IMPORTANT TAX DOCUMENT ENCLOSED.

- **1098-E** (Interest paid on student loans)
- □ <u>1098-T</u> (Tuition Statement)

- **RRB-1099-R** (Railroad Retirement)
- **1099-K** (Income through 3rd party payment network such as Uber, Lyft, Door Dash, etc.)
- □ <u>1099-C</u> (Cancellation of debt of nonbusiness credit card debt)
- □ <u>1099-S</u> (Proceeds from sale of home or real estate)
- □ <u>1099-SA</u> or <u>5498-A</u> (Distribution from HSA)
- □ <u>W-2 G</u> (Gambling winnings)
- □ Alimony Information if you paid or received alimony in 2023. You will need your former spouse's SS number.
- Personal check or bank letter showing the bank's routing number & your account number for direct deposit of refund or direct debit to pay amount due. Deposit slips are NOT acceptable.

Tax-Aide volunteers are not trained for all situations. They do NOT prepare returns that include:

- Purchase, sale, or exchange of cryptocurrency
- Bankruptcy
- \succ Rental income
- Alternative Minimum Tax, Additional Medicare Tax, or Net Investment Income Tax
- Hobby income or other activities not for profit
- Complicated Schedule K-1
- Out of state tax returns
- Self-employed with inventory
- Self-employed with Marketplace Insurance
- Self-employed with either net loss or prior year \geq carry-forward loss
