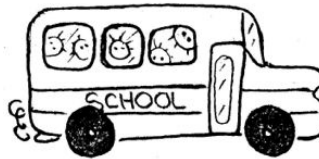

Free transportation is provided within the bus schedule areas. (See below)



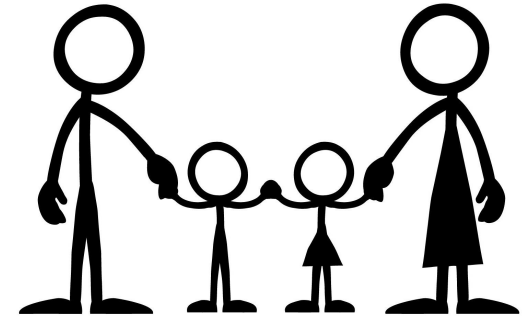
