The purpose of a school health center is to provide students and staff members with access to quality medical and mental health care that supports their health and keeps them in school. The D21 Health Center is designed to complement the services offered by the school nurse for students who may need more complex care.

Medical records remain confidential between the patient, family and our operating partner. Parents/Guardians may authorize information to be shared with the school by completing a separate consent form available from the D21 Health Center staff.

Health Center Access

All District 21 students and staff have access to the Health Center. Students must have a parental consent form on file. Consent forms may be downloaded from the Health Center webpage or picked up at the Health Center.

Location & Hours

The D21 Health Center is located on the first floor of the D21 Community Service Center and Administrative Office.

The D21 Health Center is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Check the website for any changes to the schedule. For students requiring support outside regular hours, the Chicagoland Children’s Health Alliance Pediatric Immediate Care at 3232 Lake Ave. Suite 330, Wilmette, IL 60091, is available. Services

The services offered at the D21 Health Center will be similar to those community members access at a pharmacy-based clinic.

- School and athletic physical exams
- Immunizations
- Examination, diagnosis, and treatment of pain or illness such as:
 - Ear pain
 - Eye irritation
 - Rashes or skin irritants
 - Complaints of headaches, stomachache and other minor aches
 - Minor wounds such as non-severe cuts, blisters, and skin abrasions
- Screenings for dental, vision, hearing and other problems
- Point-of-care testing (e.g., flu, glucose, strep throat, COVID-19)
- Diagnostic lab tests
- Referral for emergency treatment
- Referral for specialty medical, social service or behavioral health care
- Individual counseling session with a social worker

Cost of Services

All medical and mental health appointments, including on-site testing services, are provided at no cost.
